

Jesus is the ONLY way to the Father

- All things have been committed to me by my Father. No one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son and those to whom the Son chooses to reveal him. (Mat 11:27 NIV)
- Haven't you read this scripture: " 'The stone the builders rejected has become the capstone; (Mar 12:10 NIV)
- the Lord has done this, and it is marvelous in our eyes' ?" (Mar 12:11 NIV)
- Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned. (Mar 16:16 NIV)
- Be always on the watch, and pray that you may be able to escape all that is about to happen, and that you may be able to stand before the Son of Man." (Luc 21:36 NIV)
- He came to that which was his own, but his own did not receive him. (Jua 1:11 NIV)
- Yet to all who received him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God-- (Jua 1:12 NIV)
- For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. (Jua 3:16 NIV)
- For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him. (Jua 3:17 NIV)
- Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because he has not believed in the name of God's one and only Son. (Jua 3:18 NIV)
- Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God's wrath remains on him." (Jua 3:36 NIV)
- For just as the Father raises the dead and gives them life, even so the Son gives life to whom he is pleased to give it. (Jua 5:21 NIV)
- Moreover, the Father judges no one, but has entrusted all judgment to the Son, (Jua 5:22 NIV)
- that all may honor the Son just as they honor the Father. He who does not honor the Son does not honor the Father, who sent him. (Jua 5:23 NIV)
- You diligently study the Scriptures because you think that by them you possess eternal life. These are the Scriptures that testify about me, (Jua 5:39 NIV)
- yet you refuse to come to me to have life. (Jua 5:40 NIV)
- Then Jesus declared, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to me will never go hungry, and he who believes in me will never be thirsty. (Jua 6:35 NIV)
- I tell you the truth, he who believes has everlasting life. (Jua 6:47 NIV)
- I am the bread of life. (Jua 6:48 NIV)
- But here is the bread that comes down from heaven, which a man may eat and not die. (Jua 6:50 NIV)
- I am the living bread that came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever. This bread is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world." (Jua 6:51 NIV)
- Jesus said to them, "I tell you the truth, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of

Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you. (Jua 6:53 NIV)

- Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day. (Jua 6:54 NIV)
- For my flesh is real food and my blood is real drink. (Jua 6:55 NIV)
- Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me, and I in him. (Jua 6:56 NIV)
- Just as the living Father sent me and I live because of the Father, so the one who feeds on me will live because of me. (Jua 6:57 NIV)
- This is the bread that came down from heaven. Your forefathers ate manna and died, but he who feeds on this bread will live forever." (Jua 6:58 NIV)
- I told you that you would die in your sins; if you do not believe that I am the one I claim to be, you will indeed die in your sins." (Jua 8:24 NIV)
- I tell you the truth, if anyone keeps my word, he will never see death." (Jua 8:51 NIV)
- I am the gate; whoever enters through me will be saved. He will come in and go out, and find pasture. (Jua 10:9 NIV)
- My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. (Jua 10:27 NIV)
- I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one can snatch them out of my hand. (Jua 10:28 NIV)
- Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies; (Jua 11:25 NIV)

- and whoever lives and believes in me will never die. Do you believe this?" (Jua 11:26 NIV)
- There is a judge for the one who rejects me and does not accept my words; that very word which I spoke will condemn him at the last day. (Jua 12:48 NIV)
- Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. (Jua 14:6 NIV)
- Therefore let all Israel be assured of this: God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ. (Hch 2:36 NIV)
- Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved." (Hch 4:12 NIV)
- He then brought them out and asked, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" (Hch 16:30 NIV)
- They replied, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved--you and your household." (Hch 16:31 NIV)
- Then they spoke the word of the Lord to him and to all the others in his house. (Hch 16:32 NIV)
- At that hour of the night the jailer took them and washed their wounds; then immediately he and all his family were baptized. (Hch 16:33 NIV)
- I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes: first for the Jew, then for the Gentile. (Rom 1:16 NIV)
- and are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus. (Rom 3:24 NIV)

- so that, just as sin reigned in death, so also grace might reign through righteousness to bring eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord. (Rom 5:21 NIV)
- For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Rom 6:23 NIV)
- because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit of life set me free from the law of sin and death. (Rom 8:2 NIV)
- And if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit, who lives in you. (Rom 8:11 NIV)
- That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. (Rom 10:9 NIV)
- For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved. (Rom 10:10 NIV)
- As the Scripture says, "Anyone who trusts in him will never be put to shame." (Rom 10:11 NIV)
- for, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved." (Rom 10:13 NIV)
- Now, brothers, I want to remind you of the gospel I preached to you, which you received and on which you have taken your stand. (1Co 15:1 NIV)
- For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, (1Co 15:3 NIV)
- that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures, (1Co 15:4 NIV)
- You are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus, (Gál 3:26 NIV)
- There is one body and one Spirit-- just as you were called to one hope when you were called-- (Efe 4:4 NIV)
- one Lord, one faith, one baptism; (Efe 4:5 NIV)
- one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all. (Efe 4:6 NIV)
- that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, (Flp 2:10 NIV)
- and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. (Flp 2:11 NIV)
- and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by making peace through his blood, shed on the cross. (Col 1:20 NIV)
- For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. (1Ts 4:16 NIV)
- After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever. (1Ts 4:17 NIV)
- For God did not appoint us to suffer wrath but to receive salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ. (1Ts 5:9 NIV)
- He died for us so that, whether we are awake or asleep, we may live together with him. (1Ts 5:10 NIV)
- and give relief to you who are troubled, and to us as well. This will happen when

the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven in blazing fire with his powerful angels. (2Ts 1:7 NIV)

- He will punish those who do not know God and do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus. (2Ts 1:8 NIV)
- They will be punished with everlasting destruction and shut out from the presence of the Lord and from the majesty of his power (2Ts 1:9 NIV)
- on the day he comes to be glorified in his holy people and to be marveled at among all those who have believed. This includes you, because you believed our testimony to you. (2Ts 1:10 NIV)
- For there is one God and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus, (1Ti 2:5 NIV)
- who gave himself as a ransom for all men--the testimony given in its proper time. (1Ti 2:6 NIV)
- while we wait for the blessed hope--the glorious appearing of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ, (Tit 2:13 NIV)
- Although he was a son, he learned obedience from what he suffered (Heb 5:8 NIV)
- and, once made perfect, he became the source of eternal salvation for all who obey him (Heb 5:9 NIV)
- Therefore he is able to save completely those who come to God through him, because he always lives to intercede for them. (Heb 7:25 NIV)
- When Christ came as high priest of the good things that are already here, he went through the greater and more perfect tabernacle that is not man-made, that is to say, not a part of this creation. (Heb 9:11 NIV)

- He did not enter by means of the blood of goats and calves; but he entered the Most Holy Place once for all by his own blood, having obtained eternal redemption. (Heb 9:12 NIV)
- How much more, then, will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from acts that lead to death, so that we may serve the living God! (Heb 9:14 NIV)
- For this reason Christ is the mediator of a new covenant, that those who are called may receive the promised eternal inheritance--now that he has died as a ransom to set them free from the sins committed under the first covenant. (Heb 9:15 NIV)
- For Christ did not enter a man-made sanctuary that was only a copy of the true one; he entered heaven itself, now to appear for us in God's presence. (Heb 9:24 NIV)
- Nor did he enter heaven to offer himself again and again, the way the high priest enters the Most Holy Place every year with blood that is not his own. (Heb 9:25 NIV)
- Then Christ would have had to suffer many times since the creation of the world. But now he has appeared once for all at the end of the ages to do away with sin by the sacrifice of himself. (Heb 9:26 NIV)
- Just as man is destined to die once, and after that to face judgment, (Heb 9:27 NIV)
- so Christ was sacrificed once to take away the sins of many people; and he will appear a second time, not to bear

sin, but to bring salvation to those who are waiting for him. (Heb 9:28 NIV)

- He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; by his wounds you have been healed. (1Pe 2:24 NIV)
- But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin. (1Jn 1:7 NIV)
- My dear children, I write this to you so that you will not sin. But if anybody does sin, we have one who speaks to the Father in our defense--Jesus Christ, the Righteous One. (1Jn 2:1 NIV)
- He is the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and not only for ours but also for the sins of the whole world. (1Jn 2:2 NIV)
- No one who denies the Son has the Father; whoever acknowledges the Son has the Father also. (1Jn 2:23 NIV)
- Anyone who believes in the Son of God has this testimony in his heart. Anyone who does not believe God has made him out to be a liar, because he has not believed the testimony God has given about his Son. (1Jn 5:10 NIV)
- And this is the testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. (1Jn 5:11 NIV)
- He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life. (1Jn 5:12 NIV)
- I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life. (1Jn 5:13 NIV)
- We know also that the Son of God has come and has given us understanding,

so that we may know him who is true. And we are in him who is true--even in his Son Jesus Christ. He is the true God and eternal life. (1Jn 5:20 NIV)

- Anyone who runs ahead and does not continue in the teaching of Christ does not have God; whoever continues in the teaching has both the Father and the Son. (2Jn 1:9 NIV)
- and from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler of the kings of the earth. To him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by his blood, (Apo 1:5 NIV)
- and has made us to be a kingdom and priests to serve his God and Father--to him be glory and power for ever and ever! Amen. (Apo 1:6 NIV)
- I am the Living One; I was dead, and behold I am alive for ever and ever! And I hold the keys of death and Hades. (Apo 1:18 NIV)
- This calls for patient endurance on the part of the saints who obey God's commandments and remain faithful to Jesus. (Apo 14:12 NIV)
- The LORD your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among your own brothers. You must listen to him. (Deu 18:15 NIV)
- I will raise up for them a prophet like you from among their brothers; I will put my words in his mouth, and he will tell them everything I command him. (Deu 18:18 NIV)
- If anyone does not listen to my words that the prophet speaks in my name, I myself will call him to account. (Deu 18:19 NIV)
